Dense and powerful, it needs age to fully develop its charm and show its capacity to age beautifully. The tannins are delicious and the acidity of the wine is balanced. Winery description

The winery is located at the centre of the main viniculture area of Crete, Peza, 17 km to the north of Heraklion and 5km away from the Minoan wine press of Vathypetros. Its story starts in the middle of 19th century with main landmark Antonakis Inn, in Peza. There, travellers had the chance to refresh themselves and their animals during the trip from and to the "Chora" (Capital) at times when its gates were closed during the night.
