The grapes after harvest remain for 1 week in the sun and the final yield in wine is 20%. The fermentation of the must as well as the interruption from the production of alcohol are done in a natural way. The wine is aged for four years in ...

Winery description

At the heart of Laconia's lands, at the 17th kilometer on the national road from Sparta to Gytheio, direction Monemvasia and Mani, one can find the vineyard and winery of George Theodorakakos' family. From this area, according to tradition, nobles from Constantinople were being supplied with wine, via neighbouring Mystras. The first vines were planted at the beginning of 20th Century, from grandfather Nicolas. Today, with over 300,000 sq. meters of private owned vineyard, George Theodorakakos continues to cultivate rare local wine varieties in a t ...
